Tues 10 **let the fun begin!**

Doha is a thriving city of some two million that offers an intriguing mix of modern wonders and ancient traditions. And the sparkling skyline which we might glimpse from the air is testimony to the country's vast oil wealth. But, sorry, we don't have time for sightseeing: that'll have to wait for our next trip!

Wed 11 "Dobrý-den!" – hello Prague

Refreshed and firing on all cylinders, we head for the gate to catch our morning flight to **Prague**: the Czech Republic's Golden City. Prague sits astride the Vltava River with domes, turrets, spires, pedestrianonly streets lined with a riot of grand palaces and beautiful baroque churches. Once we've checked in to our hotel and cleaned our teeth, we're free to wrap up warmly and go for a stroll.

(December temps in Prague are mostly near zero or below – and they often get snow. Fingers crossed!)

Whatever you do, don't overlook the **Christmas Markets** – rows of brightly decorated wooden huts that sell ornaments, wooden toys, and Czech handicrafts. And grab the chance to sample some delicious plum dumplings and a steaming cup of *svarene vino* (hot mulled wine).

Thurs 12 Christmas in the Czech Republic

(B,D) 1000-year-old **Prague** boasts the most romantic setting of any European city, and (miraculously) it remained undamaged during both World Wars. So come on Kiwis: get up, get dressed, make your bed and put on your winter woollies, because today we've gotta see as much as we can.

Our sightseeing starts with a guided wander through the medieval Old Town, which takes in Hradcany Castle Grounds ... St Vitus Cathedral ... the Astronomical Clock (the oldest working clock in the world, installed in 1410) ... and the famous, much-photographed Charles Bridge.

We're free this afternoon to do more sightseeing, go shop-shopping, or browse again in Prague's exquisite Christmas Markets. Just don't get lost or lose track of time, because tonight we're off to a **Czech Dinner & Folklore Show** featuring the country's traditional food and music, song and dance!

Fri 13 to Nuremberg (Germany) & the Avalon Passion

Is it happening yet? Is your perfect Christmas wish coming true? Well, enjoy one last look around Prague, and warm your heart-&-soul with some hot local libation, before we bid goodbye — "Sbohem!"







to the Czech Republic.

Today we travel by horse-&-buggy (oh, sorry, airconditioned coach) to **Nuremberg**, Germany, with two grand highlights on our minds:

- 1. The **Nuremberg Christkindlesmarkt** the true granddaddy of Christmas Markets, one of the world's most famous. (A likely place to stock-up on souvenirs so bring your pocket-money.)
- 2. The *Avalon Passion* our chosen 5-star vessel for this Mad Midlife 'CHRISTMAS ON THE DANUBE' river cruise, with each cabin a spacious Panorama Suite featuring wall-to-wall, open-air balconies!

Have fun unpacking and finding your way around the decks ... YEEHAA!

Sat 14 Nuremberg's Christkindlesmarkt

We hope you slept well ... woke refreshed ... and enjoyed your hearty onboard breakfast? This morning we head ashore to discover what this historic German city has to offer: the storybook 900-year-old ramparts with watchtowers and gates ... the legendary Kaiserburg Castle, rated one of Europe's most formidable medieval forts ... the Schöner Brunnen (gilded fountain) in the Hauptmarkt ... the Lorenzkirche (medieval cathedral, badly smashed-up in WW2, later restored).

We also have time to roam **Nuremberg**'s Old Town, illuminated with festive lights and decorations ... and the Christmas Market, with its countless spruce stalls offering favourite Bavarian fare: such as *lebkuchen* (spiced gingerbread), *qlühwein* (hot mulled wine), and long, skinny *bratwurst* sausages.

This afternoon, if you wish, you can join an optional excursion to the Nazi Party rally-grounds in the southeast of the city (where Hitler and his National Socialist regime displayed their might) ... visit the documentation centre ... and view the *'Fascination & Terror'* exhibition.

There's live entertainment this evening as we sail to Regensburg, so put on your dancing shoes!

Sun 15 magical Regensburg (Bavaria)

Brace yourselves, Kiwis: you're gonna fall in love with this picturesque city, here in the land of mouth-watering pretzels and hand-crafted beer. Split in two by the Danube River, **Regensburg** has the Old Town on one side and its contemporary sister just across from it – and is home to more than 1000 miraculously-preserved monuments, some dating back to the Roman Empire. During the Middle Ages, the Old Town was a booming merchant city with luxury goods coming in and going out as far as China and India.

Hardly surprising this UNESCO World Heritage site is regarded as "living history"!

We join a guided stroll along cobblestone streets, past historical buildings galore ... the Old Town Hall (Altes Rathaus) ... Porta Pretoria (an arched stone gateway, built in 179 AD as the entrance to the Castra Regina fortress) ... and more. In the city's Christmas Market, you oughta track down some gingerbread and candied almonds. Go on – you won't regret it!







Mon 16 Passau: City of Three Rivers – and Salzburg

(B,L,D) We wake up this morning in **Passau**, having cruised this way last night. Since Roman times, Passau (where the rivers Inn and IIz join the Danube) has held a magnetic attraction for traders and travellers alike. Known today for its Veste Oberhaus (a 13th-century hilltop fortress) ... its baroque architecture (the distinctive onion-domed towers) ... and the world's largest organ (with 17,974 pipes) – it was once more famous for its quality swords and bladed weapons. (Ouch!)

If you haven't already filled your suitcase with gifts for the family, **Passau's Christmas Market** (set against the imposing backdrop of St Stephen's Cathedral in the Old Town) offers visitors a broad range of high-quality Bavarian-favourite. So, now's your chance: you might even get a cheap sword!

But today's top highlight is a coach-ride away in nearby **Salzburg** – the birthplace of **Mozart**. And, if you turn up your hearing-aids, you might hear a renowned composition by Wolfgang Amadeus himself.

However, we've gotta be honest: the tunes you're more likely to recognise come from a beloved 1964 Hollywood extravaganza. And if Salzburg's Mirabell Gardens, Pferdeschwemme fountain, Nonnberg Convent and Residenzplatz all look kind-of familiar, that's hardly surprising – because these hills are still alive with *The Sound of Music*.

Yes folks, this is where Maria (Julie Andrews) and the von Trapp children sang their little hearts out. So clear your throat and sing your little heart out, too!

Are you ready? On the count of three: "Doe, a deer, a female deer ..."

This evening, we cross the border and dock briefly in one of the most important Austrian cities: Linz – founded by the Romans, then a big-time trade centre, then an even bigger-time home for the Hapsburg Emperor Friedrich III.

Oh, wait! Don't leave Linz, whatever you do, until you've found a local bakery and tasted the region's famous *linzer torte* (cake). Yum ...

Tues 17 Melk in Austria's Wachau Valley

(B,L,D) Guten morgan, friends! You probably don't realise this but, at some point during the night, the **Avalon Passion** sailed into the achingly beautiful Wachau Valley, smack in the middle of Austria's world-famous wine-growing region.

After docking alongside the small town of **Melk**, we get to visit their truly magnificent **Benedictine Abbey**. Built in the early 1700s on a rocky outcrop overlooking the Danube, what began life as a royal palace was eventually gifted to Benedictine monks – who turned the estate into a fortified monastery. Today, despite being open to tourists, it continues to serve its religious purpose and is home to hundreds of pupils training to become monks.

You can't miss the Abbey's library, boasting 16,000 volumes. And the spiral staircase leading to a further 100,000 volumes, some of which are extremely valuable. But the church itself, with its stunning







frescoes and altar-pieces and its view out over the Wachau Valley, will take your breath away!

Tonight, as we sail away to our final port, Vienna, you can enjoy an Austrian cookie-tasting session. Mmm!

Wed 18 spellbinding Vienna

(B,L,D)

Rise and shine, Kiwis! Today's a BIGGIE and a BEAUT! We start with a sightseeing tour of Wien (**Vienna**) that takes us along the majestic Ringstrasse ... through the Schwarzenbergplatz (Vienna's vast town square) ... past Charles Church (Karlskirche, built in 1739 by virtue of a vow made by Emperor Charles VI during a plague) ... the iconic Opera House ... the Imperial Palace (winter residence of the Imperial Family) ... and the awe-inspiring St Stephens Cathedral with its massive South Tower.

Oh, by the way: go find a bakery on Kärtnerstrasse and sample Vienna's famous pastries!

Then, in the afternoon, we're up and off to the Schönbrunn Castle, one of Vienna's most gorgeous buildings – a World Cultural Heritage that was centre of courtly and political life under the reign of Empress Maria Theresia (died 1780).

But wait: we can't leave Vienna without doing one more thing. After dinner on board tonight, we head back into town for a spellbinding evening of classical works and waltzes by Mozart and Johann Strauss, performed brilliantly by Salon Orchestra Alt-Wien musicians in one of Europe's prettiest venues.

Thurs 19 all good things come to an end ...


